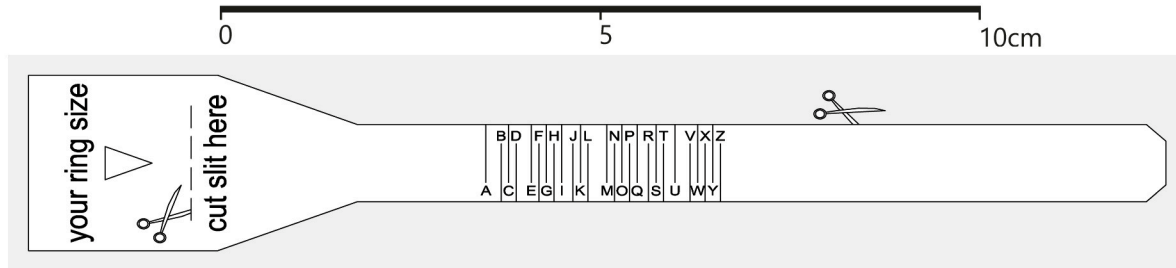


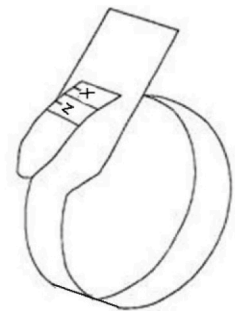

## GUIDE TO FIND YOUR CORRECT FINGER SIZE

When printing the document on A4 paper, make sure not to use the option to fit or shrink to page.  
Measure the bar below - it must be exactly 10cm long (3.94 inches).

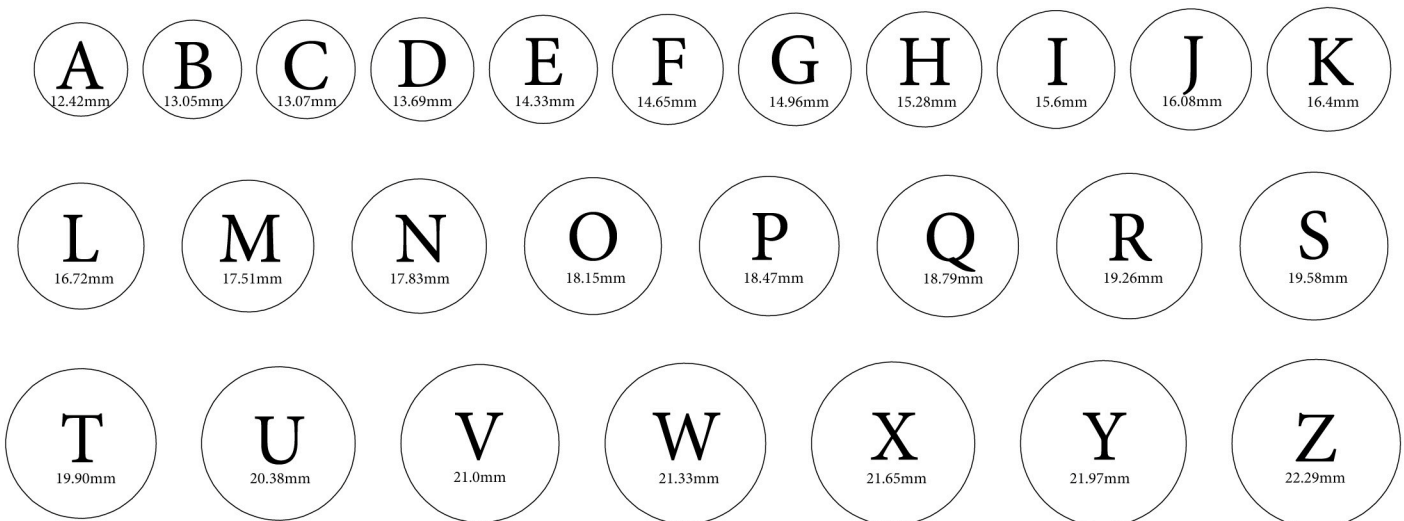
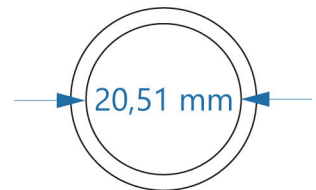


1. Cut out the sizer above.
2. Carefully cut and slit at the top the sizer (where marked A).
3. Push the slimmer end through the slit and put the ring sizer on your finger.
4. Make sure the ring sizer can move comfortably from the base of the finger over the knuckle  
Remember not to pull the sizer too tightly. It can change the reading of the size.
5. Now you are ready to read the size of your finger. If you have followed the instructions the ring will fit you perfect !



The other method to check your finger size:

1. Check a ring which you think perfectly fits the intended finger.
2. Place the ring on the circle which most closely matches the circles below.  
The inner circle should match the circle.
3. If the ring is a bit bigger or smaller than the circle below, order the larger size.
